GO BIG
 A sleek top and a voluminous back is an elegant go-to hairstyle for those who want extra volume. Celebs such as Pearl Thane and Kelly Rowland have been spotted with this look.

Most curly hair types are either not long or voluminous enough to achieve this look so hair extensions are needed. Extensions generally known as Marley hair are commonly used for this look.

If you need to fix your hair back, you can use a ponytail hairbrush to gently detangle the hair before you start to apply the hair. Then follow up with gel. Wash and seal the hair back and fasten it using another hair tie at the ends, attach the extensions to the fastenings. Fluff the hair at the back to create volume.

SKY-HIGH
 The super-high pony has been seen on the red carpet again after recently thanks to stars such as Kim Kardashian West and Cardi. Here's how to rock the look.

To achieve this look, apply conditioner at the roots of your hair and follow up with gel. Conditioner will help soften the hair and make it more pliable. You can use hair removal instead of gel, but you need to apply it after you've washed your hair. Push your hair up to the top of your head while brushing it before going to sleep. Attach a hair extension onto your hair and secure it. Cleanse at the base of your ponytail. Follow a ribbon and tie. Tie the ribbon to the length of your ponytail. The ribbon creates a solid base that makes the ponytail lighter. On some look, the ribbon and secure with pins. Tie a satin scarf or band your head to flatten your hair. Remove the scarf after a few minutes.

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BUBBLE UP
 Bubble ponytails are all the rage and can work for all hair types. They are easy to achieve and there are different ways of wearing them.

Get a thick textured hair extension and bubble hair. Use four finger systems apart from each other. To create the bubble, bubble the hair from tightly around the hair extension.

When done, spritz your hair with water and follow up with gel. Wash and smooth your hair back and forward into a bun. After that, attach the bubble hair extension onto your hair using bobby pins. Use a comb to flatten the bubble around your hair and flatten your hair. Remove the scarf after a few minutes.
